Call for Posters

Prevention 1st Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to injury prevention, is sponsoring the **3rd Annual Home Fire Drill Poster Exhibition** as part of our community-wide **Practice Your Home Fire Drill** campaign.

Practice Your Home Fire Drill is held in conjunction with the biannual message "Change Your Clock/Check Your Batteries" to encourage all households to maintain a working smoke alarm, create an exit plan, and above all practice a home fire drill twice a year.

We encourage art teachers to promote the participation of **all students K-12** in the Practice Your Home Fire Drill Poster Exhibition. The rules are simple:

- All posters must incorporate the theme of Practice Your Home Fire Drill;
- All posters must be 12" x 18" and unmounted;
- They may be done in any medium;
- Each poster should have on the back the artist's name, school, and grade level;
- Teachers will be asked to select **5 posters from each class by February 15, 2010** to be included as part of the area-wide poster display in March 2010.
- Volunteers working with Prevention 1st Foundation will pick up the posters from participating schools and deliver them for display in area malls and other public spaces, and return the posters to schools after the display period.
